## Contact

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### Wilt the Spinach

- Preheat your oven to 240°C/220°C fan/gas mark 9. Fill and boil your kettle.
- Pop the **spinach** into a colander in your sink. Pour over the **boiled water** from your kettle until wilted.
- Once wilted, squeeze out all of the excess **water** from the **spinach** with the back of a spoon.

**TIP:** You may need to do this in batches.



### Ready, Steady, Bake

- When the oven is hot, bake the **naanizzas** on the top shelf until the **cheese** is golden and bubbling, 6-7 mins.



### Start the Naanizzas

- Crumble the **goat's cheese**.
- Pop the **naans** onto a baking tray.
- Divide the **marinara sauce** between them and spread out with the back of a spoon, leaving a 1cm border.



### Dress the Rocket

- Just before you're ready to serve, add the **rocket** to a bowl and drizzle with a little **olive oil**.
- Season with **salt** and **pepper**. Toss gently to coat.



### Time for Toppings

- Sprinkle the **hard Italian style cheese** evenly over the **sauce**.
- Top each **naanizza** with the **spinach** and **goat's cheese**.
- Dollop on the **onion marmalade**.



### Serve

- When the **naanizzas** are ready, slide them onto your serving plates and cut in slices if you'd like.
- Serve the **rocket salad** alongside drizzled with the **balsamic glaze**.
