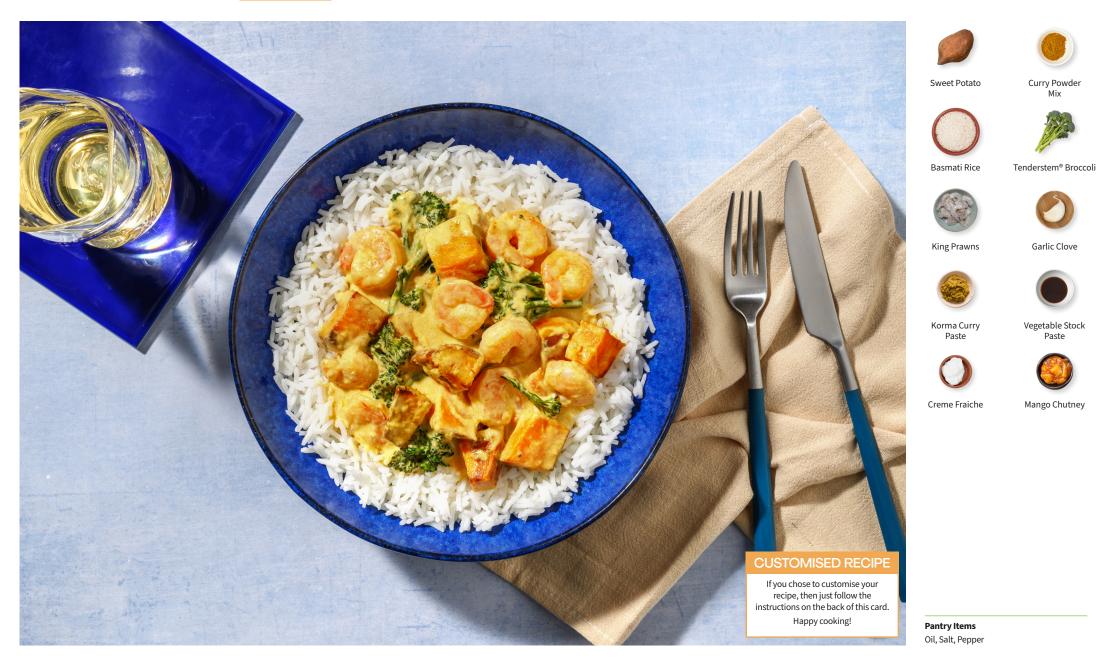


# King Prawn and Sweet Potato Korma Style Curry



with Tenderstem<sup>®</sup> Broccoli and Basmati Rice

Customised 30-35 Minutes • Mild Spice • 1 of your 5 a day



#### Before you start

Our fruit and veg need a little wash before you use them! Wash your hands before and after prep. Ingredients in red are hot!

# Cooking tools

Baking tray, saucepan, lid, garlic press and frying pan.

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# Roast the Sweet Potato

Preheat your oven to 220°C/200°C fan/gas mark 7. Chop the **sweet potatoes** into 2cm chunks (no need

to peel).

Put the **sweet potato chunks** onto a large baking tray. Drizzle with **oil**, sprinkle over the **curry powder mix** and season with **salt** and **pepper**. Toss to coat. Spread out in a single layer. TIP: *Use two baking trays if necessary.* 

When the oven is hot, roast on the top shelf until golden, 25-35 mins. Turn halfway through.



### Cook the Rice

Meanwhile, pour the **water for the rice** (see pantry for amount) into a medium saucepan with a tight-fitting lid.

Stir in the **rice** and ¼ **tsp salt** and bring to the boil. Once boiling, turn the heat down to medium and cover with the lid.

Leave to cook for 10 mins, then remove the pan from the heat (still covered) and leave to the side for another 10 mins or until ready to serve (the **rice** will continue to cook in its own steam).



# **Broccoli Time**

While everything cooks, halve any thick **broccoli stems** lengthways, then cut them into thirds. Peel and grate the **garlic** (or use a garlic press).



# Curry Up

Heat a drizzle of **oil** in a large frying pan on medium heat. Drain the **prawns**.

Once hot, add the **prawns** and stir-fry for 2-3 mins.

Next, stir in the **korma curry paste**, **garlic** and remaining **curry powder mix**. Stir-fry until fragrant, 1 min. **IMPORTANT**: *Wash your hands and equipment after handling raw prawns*.



# Combine and Stir

Stir in the **broccoli**, **veg stock paste** and **water for the curry** (see pantry for amount) and bring to the boil. Once boiling, lower the heat, cover with a lid and simmer until the the **prawns** are cooked, 4-5 mins. **IMPORTANT:** The prawns are cooked when pink on the outside and opaque in the middle.

Next, stir in the **creme fraiche** and **mango chutney**. Bring back to the boil, then remove from the heat. Season with **salt** and **pepper**.



# Finish and Serve

Once the **sweet potato** is roasted, stir it through the **curry**. Return the pan to the heat to warm through. Add a splash of **water** if it's a little too thick.

Fluff up the **rice** with a fork and share between your plates, then top with your **korma style curry**.
