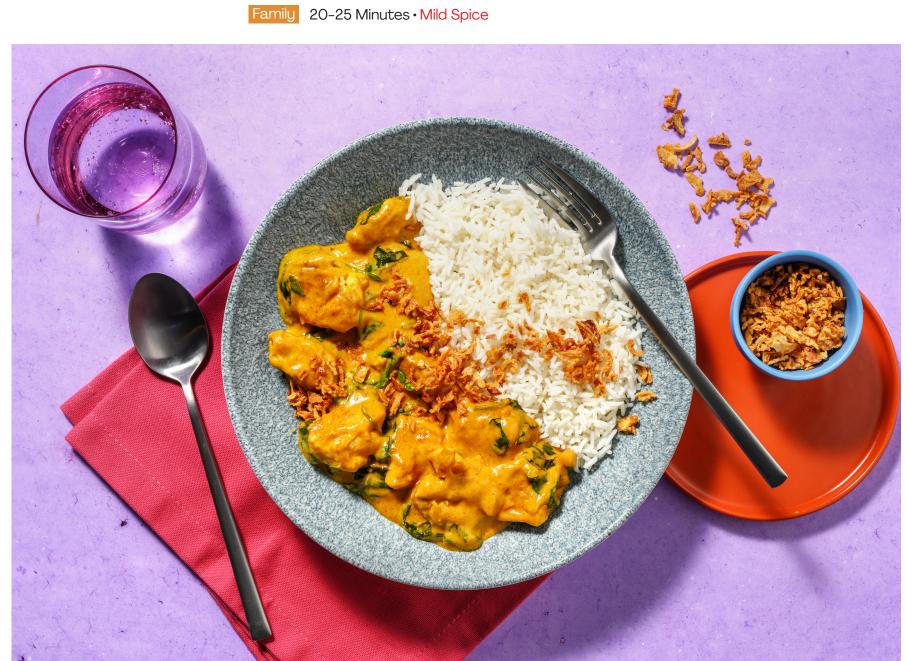


Tandoori Chicken Masala Curry

Before you start

Our fruit and veg need a little wash before you use them! Wash your hands before and after prep. Ingredients in red are hot!

Cooking tools

Kettle, saucepan, sieve, lid, frying pan and garlic press.

Use separate equipment to handle raw and cooked meat (or wash between uses). Missing or replaced ingredients, as well as any recipe step changes, will be communicated where possible via email. Be careful when adding water to hot pans while cooking.

Contact

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Cook the Rice

- a) Boil a half-full kettle.
- b) Pour the **boiled water** into a large saucepan with ¼ **tsp salt** on high heat. Add the **rice** and cook for 10-12 mins.
- **c)** Once cooked, drain in a sieve and pop back in the pan. Cover with a lid and leave to the side until ready to serve.



Fry the Chicken

- **a)** Meanwhile, heat a drizzle of **oil** in a large frying pan on medium-high heat.
- **b)** Once hot, add the **diced chicken** to the pan and season with **salt** and **pepper**.
- c) Cook until browned all over, 5-6 mins. Turn occasionally. IMPORTANT: Wash your hands and equipment after handling raw chicken and its packaging.



If you've chosen the pescatarian version, drain the **prawns**, then stir-fry, 2-3 mins. Continue as instructed, the **prawns** will cook through while simmering. **IMPORTANT**: Wash hands and utensils after handling raw prawns. Cook so they're opaque in the middle.



Add the Spices

- **a)** Meanwhile, peel and grate the **garlic** (or use a garlic press).
- b) Once the **chicken** has browned, add the **tomato puree**, **garlic** and **tandoori masala mix** to the pan.
- c) Mix well and cook until fragrant, 1 min.



Time to Simmer

- a) Next, stir in the veg stock paste and water for the curry (see pantry for amount).
- **b)** Bring to the boil, then lower the heat so the **sauce** simmers gently.
- c) Cook until the **chicken** is cooked through, 3-4 mins. IMPORTANT: The chicken is cooked when no longer pink in the middle.



Finishing Touches

- a) Once the chicken is cooked, stir in the creme fraiche, mango chutney and butter (see pantry for amount) until the butter is melted.
- **b)** Add the **spinach** to the pan a handful at a time until wilted and piping hot, 1-2 mins.
- c) Taste and season with salt and pepper if needed.
- **d)** Remove from the heat. Add a splash more **water** if you feel it needs it.



Serve

- a) Share the **rice** out between your serving bowls.
- **b)** Spoon over the **tandoori chicken masala curry**.
- c) Sprinkle over the crispy onions to finish.
