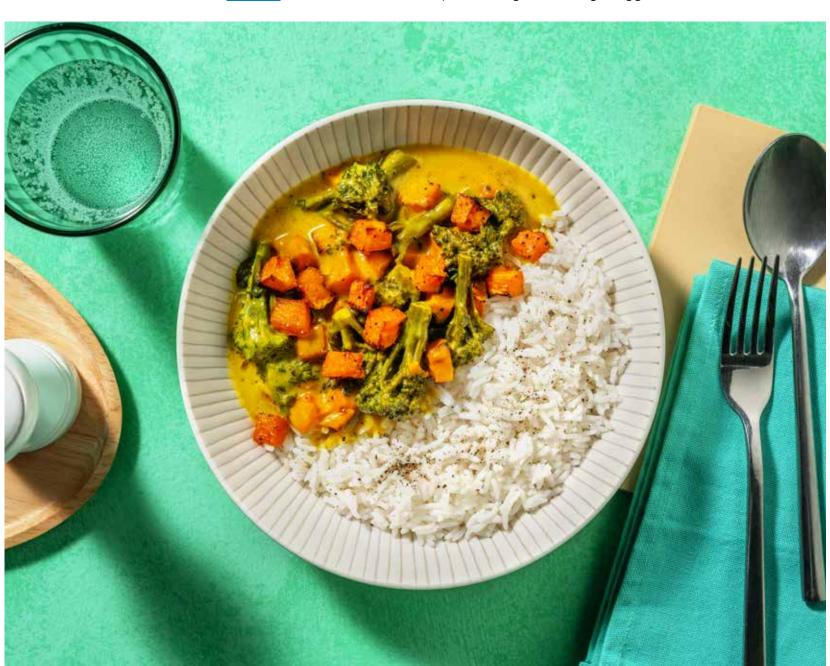

Before you start

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Roast the Sweet Potato

Preheat your oven to 220°C/200°C fan/gas mark 7.

Chop the **sweet potatoes** into 2cm chunks (no need to peel). Pop them onto a large baking tray. Drizzle with **oil**, season with **salt** and **pepper**, then toss to coat. Spread them out in a single layer.

When the oven is hot, roast on the top shelf until soft and golden, 25-35 mins. Turn halfway through.



Cook the Rice

Meanwhile, pour the **water for the rice** (see pantry for amount) into a medium saucepan with a tight-fitting lid.

Stir in the **rice** and **¼ tsp salt** and bring to the boil. Once boiling, turn the heat down to medium and cover with the lid.

Leave to cook for 10 mins, then remove the pan from the heat (still covered) and leave to the side for another 10 mins or until ready to serve (the **rice** will continue to cook in its own steam).



Broccoli Time

While everything cooks, halve any thick **broccoli stems** lengthways. Cut the **Tenderstem**® into thirds.



Curry Up

Heat a drizzle of **oil** in a large frying pan on medium heat.

Once hot, add the **korma style paste** and fry for 1 min, then stir in the **vegetable stock paste**, **sugar** and **water for the curry** (see pantry for both amounts).

Stir the **broccoli** into the **curry** and bring to the boil, then cover with a lid and simmer until the **broccoli** is just tender, 4-5 mins.



Combine and Stir

Once the **broccoli** is tender, remove the lid from the pan and stir through the **creme fraiche** until fully combined. Bring to the boil, then remove from the heat.

Once the **sweet potato** is roasted, stir it through the **curry**. Bring to the boil, then simmer on medium heat for 1-2 mins.



Finish and Serve

When ready, taste and season your **curry** with **salt** and **pepper** if needed. Add a splash of **water** if it's a little too thick.

Fluff up the **rice** with a fork and share between your plates, then top with your **korma style curry**.
